Cabbage on a stick is "Critically Endangered" and is now found naturally growing on only one sea cliff on the Hawaiian island of Kauai. Overgrazing, human activity, and competition from invasive plants have reduced this species to just a few naturally occurring individuals. The extinction of its pollinator, the sphingid moth, has made it impossible for *Brighamia insignis* to reproduce on its own. Conservationists go to great lengths to pollinate these remaining plants and to collect seeds that are planted in gardens or stored in seed banks.
