Aronia arbutifolia

Plant Sub Species or Variety:

'Brilliantissima'

Sunlight:

Requires full sun for best flower, fruit set and brilliant red fall foliage

Plant Soil Type:

Adaptable to soil type

Plant Moisture Requirements:

Can tolerate wet to dry conditions once established

(This is a shrub native to Eastern North America) and wonderful garden plant. It has nice flowers, abundant red fruit and outstanding bright red fall foliage. It can sucker into an attractive clump. Although not widely used, the botanical name has been changed to *Photinia pyrifolia* 'Brilliantissima.'
