Full sun to part shade

Plant Soil Type:

Does best in well-drained, organically rich garden soil

Plant Moisture Requirements:

Performs best with consistently moist soil, although once established, it can take dry soil

Noteworthy oakleaf cultivar due to large white blooms that fade to pink and foliage that turns bronze, maroon and purple in the fall.
