Liatris scariosa

Plant Sub Species or Variety:

var. *novae-angliae*

Liatris scariosa var. *novae-angliae*, a rare plant also known as the New England blazing star, is native to sandplain grasslands and coastal heathlands in the United States. These threatened plant communities are found primarily along the New England coast, where salt spray from the ocean, grazing and fires caused by humans historically inhibited the succession of the exposed landscape to forests dominated by woody shrubs and trees. Scientists working to protect the New England coast are currently studying the effects of carefully controlled prescribed burns in areas where fire suppression has changed the composition of its habitat. *Photo credit: USDA-NRCS PLANTS Database*
